



"Massacred for Gold" and "Pedaling Revolution" are selling well

Greg Nokes' "**Massacred for Gold: The Chinese in Hells Canyon**" is off to a fast start. **OSU Press** reports more than 1,000 copies sold in the first two weeks, with both Amazon and Powell's temporarily out of stock. The first printing was 3,000 copies, with about 250 sold during a tour of eastern Oregon and Idaho that included a packed appearance at the **Fishtrap House** in Enterprise. Nokes, a former reporter and editor at The Oregonian, will be at **Wordstock** at noon on Sunday, Oct. 11.

Another OSU Press title, Jeff Mapes' "**Pedaling Revolution: How Cyclists Are Changing American Cities,**" has just about sold out its third printing, with about 8,500 copies in print. A fourth printing of up to 5,000 copies is planned, and translation rights for Chinese and Korean editions have been sold. Mapes is a reporter at The Oregonian.
